August 7th – Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us to be on guard at all times and to be ready for the Second Coming of Christ.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: Learn to trust in the Lord like Abraham did. This week, read about Jesus' Divine Mercy and learn to trust in the One who loves us so.

August 14th – Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time
