May 4th – Third Sunday of Easter

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals Himself to the disciples for the third time.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: "To the one who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor, glory and might, forever and ever."
