AT-A-GLANCE... December's Stewardship Resources for your Parish

December 4th – Second Sunday of Advent

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, St. John the Baptist reminds us that to be a follower of God requires action on our part.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Service: As Christians, we are called to put our faith into action—this means many things, including to be at the service of others. This week, try to perform at least one additional work of mercy.

General Intercession: For all those who will not be home with their families on Christmas, that they feel God's comfort. We pray to the Lord...

December 11th – Third Sunday of Advent

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus tell St. John the Baptist's disciples of the good works He has done.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Prayer: When you read and hear of Jesus' works, have courage to turn to Him in prayer and ask Him to help you with what you are struggling with.

General Intercession: For those in need of Jesus (especially those who do not realize it). We pray to the Lord...

December 18th – Fourth Sunday of Advent

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, we hear the story of how St. Joseph trusted in God's plan for Mary and himself.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: As we wrap up the Advent season and come closer to Christmas day, use the remaining days of Advent to teach someone (perhaps a friend or child) the meaning of Christmas.

General Intercession: For our parish that we may continue to grow closer to the Lord during this last week of Advent. We pray to the Lord...

December 25th – The Nativity of the Lord

Bulletin Reflection: Jesus came into the world for us. His humility, His living and dying, His ministry was all for us—because He loves us.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Hospitality: Merry Christmas! Throughout all the days of Christmas, share God's love with all those you meet. Spread Christmas joy and Christian love to everyone!

General Intercession: For those who are lonely this Christmas season, that they may feel God's love. We pray to the Lord...
