September 5th – Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus opens the ears and loosens the tongue of the deaf man.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: In today's First Reading, we are called to preach the Good News to all we come across. You may be the vessel and witness to God that someone needs; your testimony may change someone's life.
