February 4th – Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, we hear how Jesus healed the sick and drove out demons.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Hospitality: As Catholics, we should remember that we are Christ's hands here on Earth. We are called to help those in need and protect the vulnerable (the unborn, the poor, etc.). Talk to your pastor or contact the parish/diocese to see if there any ways you can volunteer your time and practice the pillar of hospitality.

February 11th – Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: Jesus suffered death for our sins. We are called to carry our crosses, and while we do so, let us never forget how much He loves us.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: This Lenten season, dig deeper into your prayer life. Attend the Stations of the Cross, go to confession and pick up a new prayer habit. Also, during this Lenten season, you can read a Catholic spiritual or apologetics book.

General Intercession: For our parish, that as we journey through Lent, we may all grow closer to our God. We pray to the Lord...

February 25th – Second Sunday of Lent

Bulletin Reflection: In today's First Reading, we hear about Abraham's obedience to God.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Service: We, too, are called to be at service to God- we can practice that by being at service to our neighbor. Is there anyone around you (family, friends, neighbors) who can use your assistance in something?
