November 5th – Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus calls us to be humble and not proud like the Pharisees.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Service: As Catholics, we are called to humble ourselves and be at the service of others. This week, take time out of your schedule to do something for someone else.
