June 5th – Pentecost Sunday

Bulletin Reflection: During the festival of Pentecost, the Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit and were enabled to proclaim the Word of God.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: This week invite the Holy Spirit into your life and let Him guide you and inspire you. Pray to the Holy Spirit often this week and be open to where He leads you.
