### June 4<sup>th</sup> – The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

*Bulletin Reflection:* We have a loving God who gave us His only Son so that we may have eternal life. Glory and Praise be to God, forever!

*Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Prayer:* This week, be sure to take time out of each day to say “thank you” to our God for all the gifts and blessings He has bestowed on you.

*General Intercession:* In thanksgiving to our God for all the blessings we have in our life. We pray to the Lord...

### June 11<sup>th</sup> – Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

*Bulletin Reflection:* In today's Gospel, we hear a part of the Bread of Life discourse. Jesus is telling us, NOT metaphorically, that He IS the Bread of Life and we are to eat of His body.

*Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation:* 70% of Catholics do not believe that the bread and wine used for communion actually transform into the Body and Blood of Christ. Pray for those who do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist (Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity) and teach those about the beauty and miracle of the Eucharist.

*General Intercession:* That the Eucharistic Revival that our Diocese is a part of may bring about a stronger faith and devotion to the Holy Eucharist. We pray to the Lord...

### June 18<sup>th</sup> – Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Bulletin Reflection:* In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that “the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few.”

*Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Service:* We are called to be laborers for the Lord. This week, find a way to be at service for God and fellow man: perhaps donate to the Catholic Ministries Appeal or food pantry or volunteer to mow the lawn for an elderly neighbor or take them food shopping.

*General Intercession:* For all the fathers in our parish. We pray to the Lord...

### June 25<sup>th</sup> – Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Bulletin Reflection:* In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us to not worry or be afraid. We should focus on our souls and doing what we can to live a life pleasing to God.

*Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Hospitality:* This week invite someone to come to Mass with you. It could be a friend, child, sibling or parent—just make the invite!

*General Intercession:* For all seminarians who are answering God's call to serve, that they may do so with joy, courage and strength. We pray to the Lord...
