### January 4<sup>th</sup> – The Epiphany of the Lord

**Bulletin Reflection:** In today's Gospel, we hear the story of the magi.

**Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Hospitality:** As we near the end of the Christmas season, be sure to keep Christ alive in your hearts.
