July 4th – Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, the lack of faith among the community prevented Jesus from performing major miracles among them.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Service: As we enter these summer months, let us not forget those who are hungry, lonely and in need of help. Take some time this summer to bring some food to a pantry or to give to the Catholic Ministries Appeal.

July 11th – Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus summons the Twelve Apostles and sends them forth to preach the Good News, drive out demons and heal the sick.

July 18th – Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, we learn two things. One is that it is important to rest in solitude (where we can hear God's Voice), and escape from the chaos of the day. The other thing is that Jesus loves us infinitely and desires to help us in all our needs.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Prayer: This week, find some quiet time each day and read your Bible. Listen to God speak to you in the silence.

July 25th – Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Bulletin Reflection: In today's Gospel, Jesus multiplies a couple fish and barley loaves to feed five thousand people. What seemed impossible for the Apostles (feeding such a large group of people), was made possible by Jesus.

Living Stewardship ~ Pillar of Formation: Sometimes, we tend to look at things with only our human understanding. The difficulties we face, may lead us to despair and doubt. We need to learn to trust in Jesus and believe that He can help us through any problem we face.
